



Ottawa, 25th June, 1917.

Sir:-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 8th instant enclosing voucher 505 and 506 in favour of the Vernon Fruit Union and to inform you that a cheque for \$691.32 has been sent you in payment of the accounts, but the Department desires to be informed why \$70.00 a ton is charged for potatoes when your telegram of April 27th quoted the price for potatoes as \$60.00 a ton. The quantity of seed grain supplied to each Indian appears in some cases very large, and the Department desires to be informed whether it was all used for seed.
