With reference to your letter of the 23rd instant, I  
 do to say that when making payment of interest money to  
 George Fisher you should pay him only his own share. This  
 man's daughter, Mrs Steeny, has lived, it appears in the United  
 States continuously since 1912, and therefore owing to the  
 provisions of Section 13 of the Indian Act, she is not entitled  
 to participate in further distributions of interest moneys  
 made to members of the Chippewa Band of the Thames.

I transmit herewith cheque No 6141 for \$5.05 for  
 George Fisher, being payment of his share of interest money  
 for the fall of 1919.
