Memorandum for the Deputy Superintendent General:-

It is provided in the terms of the surrender of the Iwachis Indian Reserve which has been sold to the Canadian Northern Pacific Railway Company that an amount not exceeding 50% of the sum received is to be paid (distributed) to the band. There is also the sum of \$100.00 to be first paid to the Indian, Gaelic, for a house he had on the said reserve. The balance is therefore \$5200.00, 50% of which may be distributed among the members of the band. I beg to recommend that the matter be referred to the Accountant for action. (See letters from Agent C. A. Cox of Feb. 25 and Aug 4, last.)
