Circumcision.
The new year begins roughly. Cold continues severe. Considerable wind, and when it ceases, snow falls.
Epiphany.
Changeable.

1st Sunday after Epiphany.
Sharp frost. Real Canadian cold weather continues. S.-W. wind brings snow. N.-E. fair and frosty. Agreeable travelling. Weather moderated.

2nd Sun. after Epiphany.
This week will be very variable in weather but toward the 19th look for change with wind and snow afterward; prepare for January thaw.

3rd Sunday after Epiphany.
Cold, damp and looks more like rain than snow.
Conversion of St. Paul.
The January thaw comes with the moon's change. Uncomfortable day.

4th Sunday after Epiphany.
The end of month threatens cold rain or snow.
