

The advance of the season has brought another appropriate reduction in both sweet and sour cream. The former has dropped from \$7 to 83 cents per pound of butter fat, while sour cream for buttermaking purposes has also declined two cents, namely, from 22 to 20 cents. Sweet milk holds steady at \$1.50 per 100 pounds, which quotation will probably remain for the balance of the month. The season flow is now on liberal quantities of every class being offered. The opinion is general among dealers that cream will not go lower, as the sweet cream is already down to last year's quotation. Indeed a rise in price inside of three weeks would not surprise them, as the Eastern demand remains constant and is expected to get even stronger.
