Resolved, that this House will, to-morrow, resolve itself into a Committee of the whole House, on the said amendment.

The order of the day, for putting the question of concurrence on the amendments reported by a Committee of the whole House, to the Bill for erecting a Common Gaol in the District of Three Rivers, and to provide the means for defraying the expenses thereof, being read;
