On Motion the House resolved itself into a Committee of the whole House on the further Confideration of His Excellency the Governor's Message, respecting Fees to be paid to the Attorney General, and the Report of the Committee of this House on said subject.

Mr. Speaker left the Chair, Mr. Pyke, took the Chair, Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair,

The Chairman reported from the Committee, that they had confiderd the subject to them referred, and had come to a Resolution thereupon, which they had directed him to report to the House, and he read the same in his Place, and afterwards delivered it in at the Clerk's Table, where it was read, and is as follows,

Resolved, That it is the Opinion of this Committee, that His Excellency the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief for the Time being, should be authorized to draw by Warrant on the Treasury the Sum of £.222 4 5, to be paid to the Attorney General for his Services for the ensuing Year, in lieu of all Fees he is entitled to receive from His Majesty; and thereupon,

On Motion, resolved, That a Copy of the said Resolution be delivered to his Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, by a Committee of this House in Answer to

his Excellency's Message.

Ordered, That Mr. Wallace, Mr. Solicitor General, and Mr. Hartshorne, be a Committee accordingly.

On Motion resolved, That a Conference be defired with the Council, on the subject of the Quarantine Bill, now before the Council.

Ordered, That the Clerk do acquaint the Council therewith, Ordered, That Mr. Solicitor General, Mr. Wallace, Mr. Hartshorne Mr. Tonge,

and Mr. Belcher, do manage the faid Conference.

Mr. Wallace reported from the Committee appointed to wait on his Excellency the Lieutenant Governor with the Resolution of this House, on the subject of an allowance to the Attorney General in lieu of Eees: that his Excellency had been waited on accordingly.

A Message from the Council by Mr. Gautier.

Mr. Speaker,

The Council have agreed to the Resolve of this House on the subject of an Allowance to the Attorney General, in lieu of Fees.

The Council agree to the Conference as defired by this House immediately

in the Committee Room of the Council.

The Council defire a Conference with this House by Committee, on the subject of the Bill relating to Public Buildings. And then the Messenger withdrew.

Refolved, That this House do agree to the Conference as defired by His Majesty's

Ordered, That the Clerk do acquaint the Council therewith.

Ordered, That the Managers who are appointed to confer with the Council on the Quarantine Bill do manage this Conference, and the Names of the Managers were called over, and they went to the Conference accordingly,

And being returned. Mr. Solicitor General reported, That the Managers had held a Conference with the Council on the subject of the Quarantine Bill, and also the Bill relating to the public Building's respectively, and stated the Substance of the said Conferences

to the House.

Then the House adjourned till To-morrow at Ten of the Clock.
