

Of the Vestry of *St. John's Church*, in the Township of *Kingston*; praying for the passing of an Act to permit of the sale of Rectory Lands in this Province.

Of *Lions Harwich*; setting forth certain grievances, and praying for redress in the premises.

Mr. *Somerville*, from the Standing Committee on Standing Orders, presented to the House, the Fourteenth Report of the said Committee, which was read, as followeth:—

Your Committee have examined the Notices given upon the following Petitions; and find them sufficient, viz.:—of the Municipal Council of the County of *Perth*, for an Act to consolidate their debt; of the Canadian Loan and Investment Company (Limited); and of *l'Institut Canadien Français de la Cité d'Ottawa*.

On the Petition of *John Elliott*, Mayor, and others, of the Town of *Brantford*, for authority to the Town Council of *Brantford*, to erect a Drill Shed on a certain piece of land, your Committee find that no notice was given; but as no private rights can be affected by it, they recommend a suspension of the Rule relative to Notice.

Mr. *Morris*, from the Standing Committee on Miscellaneous Private Bills, presented to the House, the Thirteenth Report of the said Committee, which was read, as followeth:—

Your Committee have considered the following Bills, and have prepared amendments to each, which they submit for the consideration of Your Honorable House, viz.:—

Bill, to amend the Acts relating to the Corporation of the City of *Montreal*, and for other purposes.

Bill, to authorize the *Hartford Oil Company* to hold and convey certain lands.

Bill, to make further provision in relation to the Temporalities of the United Church of *England* and *Ireland* in this Province.

Bill, to permit the issuing of a Patent for a certain new and useful invention to *Henry John Boswell*.

Bill, to vest the Protestant Burial Ground at *Hudson*, in the Incumbent and Churchwardens of *St. James' Church, Vaudreuil*.

Bill, to authorize the issue to Messrs. *J. D. Whelpley* and *J. J. Storrer*, of Letters Patent for a new and improved system of treating metallic ores.

Bill, to incorporate the *Crystal Lake Cemetery*.

Bill, to enable *John Auld* to sell certain real estate.

They have also considered the following Bills, and have agreed to report the same, without amendment, viz.:—

Bill, to remove doubts as to the legality of a Canon of the Synod of the Diocese of *Quebec*, respecting the Parish and Chapelrys of *Quebec*.

Bill, to declare and settle the construction of the Marriage Settlement of *Harriette Margarette Gage*, and confirming assurances made thereunder.

Bill, to erect the County of *Peel* into a separate County, for judicial purposes.

Bill, to naturalize *John Rogers*.

Bill, to divide the Municipality of *Gaspé Bay, South and York*, into two separate Municipalities.

Bill, to extend the provisions of the Act 25 Vic., chapter 40, intituled, "An Act to confirm and establish certain Roads in the Township of *Reach*."

Bill, to amend certain errors in a conveyance from one *Alexander Dixon*, deceased, to *W. M. Westmacott*, dated 1st September, 1854, and to confirm a sale of certain lands thereunder.

Bill, to erect *St. Bonaventure* into a separate Municipality.

Bill, to authorize the admission of *William Lynn Smart*, as a Barrister in *Upper Canada*.

Bill, to amend the Act 23 Victoria, chapter 123, incorporating the Pilots for and below the Harbour of *Quebec*.

In reporting the last-mentioned Bill, Your Committee desire to call the attention of Your Honorable House to the importance of the principle involved in the provision for amending the Pilots Act contained in the Bill.

The Bill to amend the Act 29 Victoria, chapter 57, respecting the incorporation of
