Of Lions Harwich; setting forth certain grievances, and praying for redress in the

premises.

Mr. Somerville, from the Standing Committee on Standing Orders, presented to the House, the Fourteenth Report of the said Committee, which was read, as followeth :-

Bill, to authorize the admission of William Lynn Smart, as a Barrister in Upper Canada.

Bill, to amend the Act 23 Victoria, chapter 123, incorporating the Pilots for and

below the Harbour of Quebec.
