Anno Ostavo Regis GEORGII III. CAP. I.

At the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of the Province of Nova Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on the Twenty Eighth Day of May, Anno Domini 1765, in the Fifth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, of Great Britain, France, and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, &c. and there continued by feveral Prorogations until the Eighteenth Day of June, Anno Domini 1768, in the Eighth Year of His faid Majesty's Reign, being the Sixth Sellion of the Fourth GENERAL ASSEMBLY convened in the faid Province.

CAP. I.

An ACT for granting to His Majesty, a Duty on Wheel Carriages within the Peninfula of Halifax.

WW HEREAS it is expedient that the Public Highways with W & in the Peninfula of Halifax, and the Streets of the Tow and Suburbs thereof, should be properly maintained and kept Preamble. igtimes in good Repair, for the U/e, Benefit, and Advantage, as well of the Inhabitants as of the People who refort from the Country to the principal Seat of Government : And Whereas it is just and necesfary that a Revenue be raifed towards defraying the Expences that may be thereby incurred, We His Majcsty's most dutiful and loyal Subjects, the Reprefentatives of this Province met in General Affembly, being defirous to make Provision in this Cafe, have resolved to give and grant unto His Majesty, the Duties hereinaster mentioned, and We do humbly pray that it may be enacted, and Be it Enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council, and Affembly, That from and after Duty laid upon the First Day of August One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty Wheel Carriages Fight there shall be raised levied collected and naid unto His within the Penin-Eight, there shall be raised, levied, collected and paid, unto His Majefty, His Heirs, and Royal Succeffors, for the public Ufe of Tea Shiilings for this Province, and the Support of the Government thereof, for cachPair of Wheels, each and every Wheel Carriage used within the Peninfula of Halifax, drawn by one or more Horses or by Oxen, for each Pair of Wheels of fuch Carriage, a Duty of Ten Shillings, which Duty shall be paid by the Owners or Proprietors of such Carriages (excepting
