MARKETS and FINANCE TORONTO MARKETS. Live Stock Market. Receipts of live stock at the City Market, at 10 o'clock, for Wednesday and Thursday, were 71 car loads, composed of 991 cattle, 1,224 hogs, 185 sheep, 93 calves, and 457 hogs to packers direct.

New York Sugar Market. Sugar, raw firm; fair refining, 3.86c; centrifugal, 95 test, 4.36c; molasses sugar, 3.81c; refined, firm.

Peas. Farmers in the neighborhood of Owen Sound this week received 97c per bushel for peas, which they claim is the highest price reached in twenty years. An active demand is created by the fact that a firm there is filling orders for peas to the Barbadoes. This price is ten cents higher than the Toronto quotation.

Financial Items. Copper in London is 2s 6d lower to-day. New York banks lost \$3,000,000 through sub-treasury operations since Friday last.

Stocks and Bonds New York, March 27.-The market during the morning developed important buying in the Union Pacific, Reading, Copper, A. B. & Steels, London bought A. C. P. and other stocks. The most influential selling was in Reading and A. R. Commission houses were selling more than purchased. The metal trade also, which has been very pessimistic, now says advice from all parts of the country are of an encouraging nature.

Farmers' Market. The offerings of grain to-day were small, consisting of only one load of fall wheat, which sold at 91c a bushel. Hay in fair supply, with prices steady; 25 loads sold at \$10 to \$20 a ton. Straw, firmer, three loads selling at \$17 a ton. Dressed hogs are limited in supply, with prices firm. Light sold at \$7.50 to \$7.75, and heavy at \$7.25.

Indian Title for Pale Face. The chiefs of the six nations in New York, through the Onondaga tribe, which has been the keeper of the archives throughout the history of the Iroquois Confederacy, have conferred on Director John M. Clarke, of the New York State Museum, the title of Hos-sa-na-ga-da, the Keeper of the Name, in recognition of his official custodianship of the Iroquois wampum, which were transferred to the State in 1888. The title is to be transmitted in perpetuity with the directorship of the State Museum.
