In deference to the expressed wishes of the employees of several establishments, their contributions are shown only in the aggregate.

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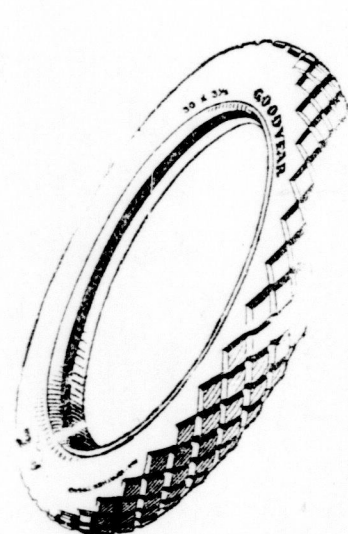
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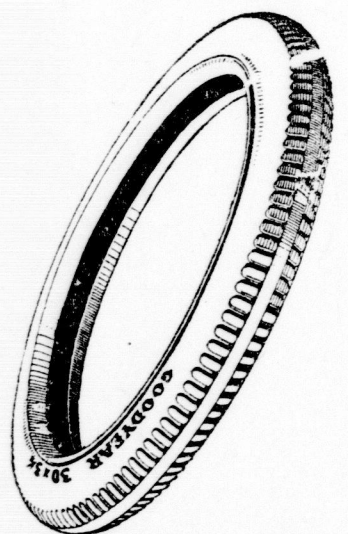


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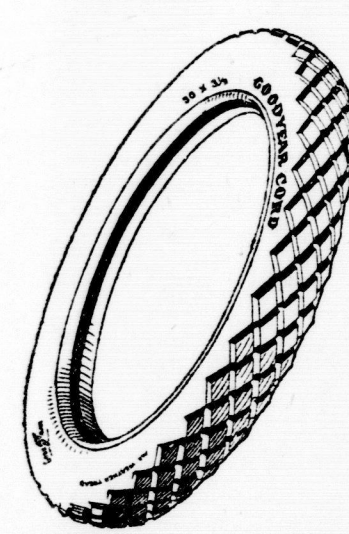


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
