

How Tien Tsin Was Captured

The Grim Realities of the Fighting Detailed by Correspondents.

Desperate Resistance of the Chinese in the Face of Murderous Fire.

A very complete detailed account of the attack and capture of the native city of Tien Tsin by the allies, from which the Chinese had been bombarding the foreign concession, was brought by the Empress of China. The war correspondent of the Kobe Chronicle tells the story as follows:

With woefully incomplete knowledge, and with preparations equally insufficient, we marched on a mass of infantry of 3000 men, a 90-foot stone wall, and were beaten back with heavy loss. The movement began last night (July 12). At a council of war yesterday, all the commanders of the different forces agreed that it was impossible to let the Chinese continue bombarding the settlement. Their shell fire had to be silenced and then the city rushed, cost what it might. Some of the troops moved out before midnight, and the others between 2 and 4 in the morning. The Russians, Germans and half of the French took the east and west sides of the city, while the Japanese, Americans, Austrians and Italians operated on the south and west. Tien Tsin native city lies in the angle of the Grand Canal and the Pei Ho river. The canal goes nearly from west to east at this point, ending in the Pei Ho, which runs tortuously from north to south. The foreign concession is south, along the river on its right or west bank. A mud wall, about 20 feet high and two feet thick at base, forms a rough circle, enclosing the native city and concession, besides a big extent of fields on both sides of the river. On the outer side of this wall is a moat, 20 to 30 feet wide, and ranging up to 10 feet in depth, with three or four bridges on the west and several on the east. Inside the mud wall, between the concession and the river, the western or Hai-kwang arsenal, with a moat and wall around it. This is opposite the west gate of the city and about a mile from the river, with several patches of water between, varying much in width and depth according to the rains, but mostly impassable except by a narrow bridge. About half of the plain within the mud wall is occupied by suburbs of the native city, great straggling colonies of houses, with streets usually narrow and winding. The south gate of the city opens into a big suburb of this kind, which in its continuity was under the bank merges into the French concession; next coming the British, then the German and Japanese, hardly yet much developed, but with a few houses, the canal is the principal fort which has been bothering us so terribly, firing over the city into the concession, and the whole place is battered, although most of the houses are still standing. Perhaps one-third is in utter ruin, heaps of smouldering debris and portions of blackened walls, especially in the French concession. This has been the happy hunting ground of Chinese snipers, who would creep among the ruins at night and pot people in the streets of the British concession all day long. And there was almost no chance of their doing this, you do with a hundred acres of dismantled masonry full of sharpshooters? Across the river, along its left or east bank, are many acres of burnt-out buildings, from which also the merrymurderous snipers used to play their game quite recently.
