MORE WHEAT AND BETTER THE RULE

Ten Times As Much Hard Wheat Will Be Threshed in Alberta This Year Than Last.

Calgary, Sept. 30—The quantity of hard wheat threshed in Alberta, this year, will be ten times as much as last year. The prospect is that at least half of the nineteen hundred is that at least half of the nineteen numered and twelve crops will grade No. 1 hard and No. 1 and No. 2 Northern. Up to date George Hill, government grain inspector, has inspected more than half as much No. 1 Hard as was inspected altogether last year. Only two cars of No. 1 Hard, white fife, selling in two cars of No. I Flard, white ine, seiling in Winnipeg as No. I Northern, were shipped to Calgary in 1911, but three ears of this particular wheat were inspected here during the current month. It is estimated that the total output of first grade wheat this year will be about three hundred carloads, as compared with \$87 carloads in 1921. with 281 carloads in 1911.
