from the Novelty of the Composition, rarely attempted among us, and the Excellence of the Object it celebrates.

An Address to none but you, Gentlemen, seemed proper on this Occasion; because, as it is your County that gave Birth to, and nursed the Hero, it was but just you should, on that Account, share in the Elogiums, which are due to his Merit; and even pride yourselves, that, with the general Applause of the Nation, you can again add to your List of Kentish Worthies, in Church and State, in the Army and Navy, the Name of a Man of Kent, who is the Glory of the present Age, and will be the Admiration of the suture.

Go on, GENTLEMEN, and prosper. May you never want a Race of Heroes; and may every Man among you, in the Support and Desence of his Country, prove himself a TRUE MAN OF KENT, which is the hearty Wish of,
