The matter is pending before the Commission.</p> <p>In the case of four alleged civilian internees detailed in POULO CONDORE prison, the Government of the Republic of Viet-Nam, in November, 1956, stated that they are common law prisoners. The Commission in January, 1957, asked the Government of the Republic of Viet-Nam to give details about the nature of the offence and charges under which they were tried and convicted. These have been furnished. The matter is under consideration.</p> <p>In the case of two persons who were released in South Viet-Nam, the Commission asked the Government of the Republic of Viet-Nam in July, 1956, to produce their dossiers within three weeks to determine their status. The dossiers have not been supplied.</p> <p>In the case of four alleged civilian internees detained at PHU QUOC, the Government of the Republic of Viet-Nam stated that their names are not mentioned in the list of prisoners detained at PHU QUOC.</p> <p>In the case of four alleged civilian internees detained in POULO CONDORE prison, the Commission recommended the supply of dossiers in March, 1956. The Commission has not received the dossiers.</p>
