QUARTER: 1 TO HAVE A CDN COMPANY QUALIFY FOR AND BID ON ONE OR MORE OF THE FIVE URBAN GAS DISTRIBUTION PROJECTS.

VP OF CONGAS VISITED TURKEY. CONSORTIUM AGREEMENT WAS NEGOTIATED WITH LOCAL & FOREIGN PARTNERS. DECISION ON WHETHER TO BID ISTANBUL DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS EXPECTED MOMENTARILY. IT IS EXPECTED THAT CONSORTIUM WILL BID ON OTHER PROJECTS.

QUARTER: 2 -ENCOURAGE AND ASSIST CONGAS IN BIDDING ON ONE OR MORE OF THE FIVE URBAN GAS DISTRIBUTION PROJECTS IN TURKEY.

-CONGAS HAS FORMED A CONSORTIUM WITH GAZ METROPOLITAIN OF QUEBEC, NOVACORP OF CALGARY AND NATURGAS SYD OF DENMARK. CONSORTIUM WILL BE BIDDING FOR THE BURSA AND ESKISEHIR GAS DISTRIBUTION PROJECTS.

QUARTER: 3 ASSIST CONGAS IN THE PREPARATION & PRESENTATION OF BIDS ON TWO OR THREE URBAN GAS DISTRIBUTION PROJECTS.

CONGAS HAS SUBMITTED A PROPOSAL TO TURKISH GOV'T FOR 2 URBAN GAS DISTRIBUTION PROJECTS. COMPANY OFFICIALS VISITED MUNICIPALITIES OF BURSA, ESKISEHIR & IZMIT. CONGAS HAS BEEN WORKING ON FORMING A CONSORTIUM WITH FOREIGN CO. SEV. CDN PARTNERS
