Information designation and classification on SIGNET 2000+

SIGNET 2000+ is an Unclassified and Protected A network. Information which is Protected B, C, Confidential or Secret may be processed only on workstations designated for that purpose (i.e. SIGNET -C4) and the documents so processed may be stored only on designated floppies and in secure storage locations.

Installing Software on SIGNET 2000+

On SIGNET 2000+ any installation should be done in conjunction with your SA.

SIGNET 2000+ User Access

SIGNET 2000+ users will be able to access their account from any SIGNET 2000+ workstation in the world using the above procedure. However, when visiting SIGNET-D/ICONDESK sites, SIGNET 2000+ users will need the assistance of a Local SA to login to their account.

To Login to SIGNET 2000+:

- 1. Turn SIGNET 2000+ workstation on.
- 2. Press CTRL+ALT+DELETE when prompted to do so.
- 3. Click OK.
