CANADIAN DELEGATION TO PRESIDENTIAL
INAUGURATION IN BRAZIL

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, announced today the composition of the Canadian delegation to the inaugural ceremonies of the new President of the Federative Republic of Brazil, His Excellency Tancredo de Almeida Neves. The Canadian delegation will be led by the Honourable Harvie Andre, P.C., M.P., Minister of Supply and Services, who will be accompanied by the Canadian Ambassador to Brazil, Mr. Anthony T. Eyton.

The inaugural ceremonies of President Neves will take place in Brasilia on March 15, 1985.

After the inauguration, the Minister will travel to Sao Paulo where he will address the Brazil-Canada Chamber of Commerce.
