nuclear policy for Canada, the government has in the specific area of commercial enterprise, which he mentioned, been pursuing new opportunities for sales of Candu reactors abroad. At the moment we are actively pursuing new possibilities in Mexico and Japan and additional possibilities in Korea and Roumania. I do not think in that area there is any lack of direction by the government, as the hon. member suggests.
