Westminster Columbian: The heavy rain of Tuesday night, and the breaking up of the winter in Kamloops district, caused heavy floods and several washouts on the Thompson section, delaying No. 1 and 2 which were held over night at North Bend and Kamloops. This is the first serious delay this winter on the Pacific division, and it is expected it will be the only one. The snow slides are about all down in the mountains and owing to the snow sheds and other improvements, they have caused no delay to trains to speak of.


