

160.—Being in Greek Cross, to Re-form Sections.

Reform Column of Sections.—On the word SEC-TIONS, each Section Commander will command:

1st Section Commander, No. 1 section on the left form section.

2nd Section Commander, No. 2 section, left incline.

3rd Section Commander, No. 3 section mark time, and, when second section is in column, forward.

Forward.—4th Section Commander, No. 4 section on the left form section, mark time, and, upon section distance being formed, the Captain General will give the command, "Forward."

161. Being in Column of Squads, to Form Passion Cross.

Step Short, Form Passion Cross.—On the word CROSS, the Section Commanders will command as follows:

1st Section Commander, No. 1 squad, advance in file from the right; No. 2 squad, right incline.

2nd Section Commander, No. 3 squad, right incline; No. 4 squad, left incline.

3rd Section Commander, 5th and 6th squads advance in file from the right.

4th Section Commander, 7th and 8th squads advance in file from the right.

The second squad inclines to the right, then left incline, dressing on the right of the third squad; the third squad inclines to the right half its width, then advances (the threes in the third squad separating slightly to allow the colors to march through by file); the fourth squad inclines to the left, and takes up their dressing on the left threes of the third squad; the fifth,
