

RIDEAU CLUB.

CONSTITUTION.

ART. 1.—This Association shall be known as the RIDEAU CLUB of Ottawa.

ART. 2.—Politics and religious questions of every description shall be absolutely excluded from the objects of the Club. Politics & religion.

ART. 3.—Each candidate for admission shall be proposed by one member and seconded by another, by a proposal in writing, to be inserted in the book of Candidates, and signed by both mover and seconder, and shall be balloted for at a ballot which may take place after the name of the Candidate and his proposer and seconder have been posted in the Coffee Room, under the hand of the Secretary, and notice of intended ballot mailed to each member not resident and not represented by proxy in Ottawa, at least ten days immediately before the day of ballot. No ballot shall be valid unless twenty-one members actually ballot, and members may ballot by proxy, which proxy shall be filed with the Secretary, and one black ball in seven shall exclude. Candidates.

ART. 4.—The ballot shall take place between the hours of Ten A. M., and Six P. M., Rules of ballot.
