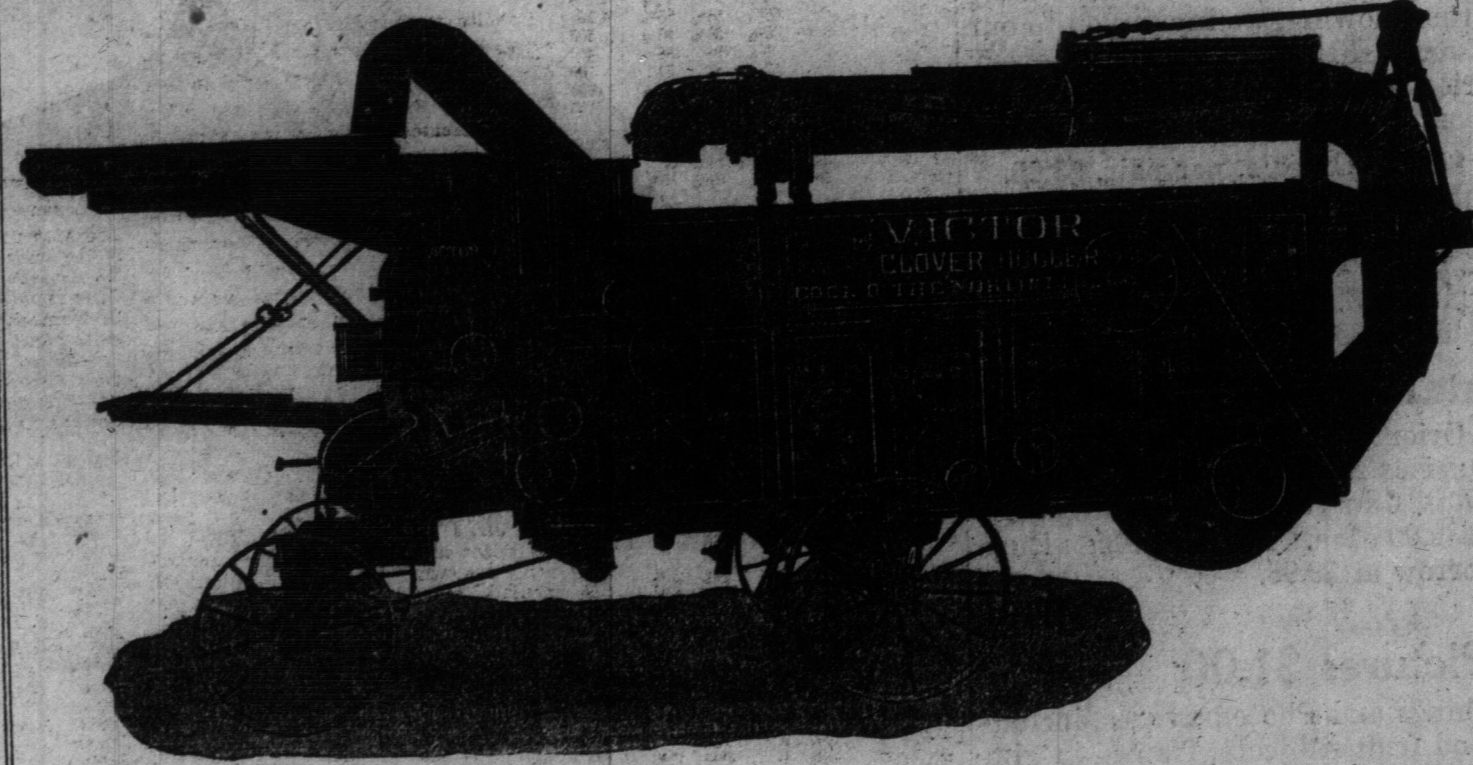

ONTARIO APPLE BELLS GREATEST IN WORLD

Section Down East That is as Good as a Gold Mine to Fortunate Owners of Orchards.

Receipts of live stock at the Union Yards were 122 carloads, consisting of 2067 cattle, 906 sheep and 20 calves. The quality of fat cattle, as a rule, was not as good as that of last week.

There was one American export buyer on the market to-day. The prices paid by him in the face of a declining British market, speak volumes for him as a straightforward, honorable man, and by so doing he added many more to his already long list of Canadian friends.

Butchers' cattle of good quality were in demand and sold readily at 10c to 15c per cwt. higher, and more could have been sold. There were three picked cattle, 100 lbs. each, at \$5.25; 100 lbs. at \$5.00; 100 lbs. at \$4.75.

Trade was not as large nor as brisk as usual for feeders. Short-keepers are worth from \$5.25 to \$5.50; good steers, \$6.00 to \$6.25; stockers, \$4.00 to \$4.25.

Prices for sheep and lambs were 30c per cwt. higher than last week. Lambs sold at \$6.00 and sheep at \$5 per cwt. See sales given below.

None on sale. W. J. Johnston, buyer for Gunns, reports prices as follows: Salecids, fed and watered, \$7.10, and \$7.75 to drovers for hogs 1.0 lb. cars at country points.

Many years ago, when apples were considered good enough for the orchard, now this has changed. The best land is planted with orchard. New orchards are being laid out yearly.
