The membership of this Union for the past year has been twentysix. Two honorary members. Average attendance at weekly meetings, seven.

The first meeting in each month is in Association Hall, with the District Monthly Devotional Meeting, when all the city Unions are expected to unite.

Sickness and family affliction among a number of our members has prevented as much work being done as we would have wished, but the few worked faithfully and well. Early in the winter a series of evangelistic services were commenced in a poor locality, two sisters having charge each week. The Superintendent reports sixteen meetings held; seventy-five signed the pledge; 114 visits were made among the poor, and a large quantity of tracts and leaflets distributed. By an oversight no account of these was kept. Thirty-four visits were made between the fire halls, gaol and railway station; 1,069 papers and 1,678 tracts were distributed. This Union had charge of the tent in the Fair Grounds for one day, and contributed 5,000 pages of literature for distribution.
