THE MAYOR IS RIGHT

The suggestion of Mayor Hayes that a comprehensive plan of street work for next year should be considered and approved as soon as possible ought to commend itself to the council. There is great need of improvement of a number of important streets, where the work should be of a permanent character.

THE PROPOSED LAND TAX

In reference to the proposed tax on land, to which allusion was made in the Times yesterday, the following are the resolutions adopted at the single tax conference at Niagara Falls, and which will be pressed upon parliament by a delegation from the Canadian Committee for Taxation of Land Values.

on land values of Canada would produce an additional revenue of approximately eighty million dollars per annum, with a maximum of equity and certainty, and may be collected through existing organizations with a minimum of expense.

"One of the most important acts of the Canadian Tax Reform Conference held at Niagara Falls in August was the recommendation to the Dominion government to levy a tax upon the land values of the Dominion to provide for the carrying on of the war and the financing of the burden which the war has made inevitable.

The President's declaration will be welcomed by the Allies, and would be more welcome if he followed it by action in the matter of the violation of Germany's pledge to him when it was only the presence of American warships that saved the lives of victims of the U-38 at the very door of the United States.

The Teutonic advance in Dobruja is halted by the Danube River. On the Transylvania border the Roumanians claim to be holding their own. Thus far, therefore, the enemy has failed to get a decision in Roumania, and the fear that the country may be overrun is not as great as it was a short time ago.

FURTHER REPORT OF HOSPITAL CHANGES

London, Oct. 26.—(Montreal Gazette Cable)—Following the new policy recently inaugurated in the Canadian Medical Services the Montreal Gazette correspondent gathers that several prominent medical and surgical men will come from Canada to assist in the care of the sick and wounded.

Dr. Hadly Williams, a leading Ontario surgeon, has been invited to accept the position as head of the surgical section of the Ontario hospital at Orpington. Other changes, it is understood, include the resignation of Lieut.-Col. J. McCombe, A. D. M. S. of the London area, who will probably take charge of a hospital in England.
