Organizations handling the vacant lot work should give the matter of weed destruction early attention; otherwise, the lots will not only prove a menace to the land in the vicinity by the spread of weed seeds, but create antagonism to the movement on the part of the occupiers of the neighboring land.

## The Disease-Carrying Cat

(By John Huber, M. D.)

There is at least one society (its membership is made up in large part of elderly maiden ladies) for the preservation of cats against the onset of wicked small boys and against those cruel doctors who would vivisect cats under the base pretense of benefiting human-kind. There is here no desire to hurt anybody's feelings, but only to instruct all who, if the choice must be made, would prefer to be tenderly careful of child life, rather than to manifest a perverse sociophilia by pampering stray, ownerless, oftentimes infected, many cats—filthy, biting, scratching cats—which would be far better off, from every rational and essentially humane point of view, in the lethal chamber. Many such cats are a serious menace to human health and life. Medical literature sets forth succinctly how the infections of diphtheria, grippa, the common cold, pneumonia, tuberculosis, mumps, measles, scarlet fever, ring worm, typhus, typhoid, and relapsing fever, cholera, dysentery, summer complaints, surgical infections, foot-and-mouth disease, tapeworm, tetanus, and rabies have been transmitted to human-kind by the agency of cats. Moreover nearly six per cent (5.9) of cats are reported to have cancer, and there is also a well-defined cat asthma—the paroxysm of difficult breathing, gray face, and blue lips being brought on by the inhalation of cat emanations, as hay fever or rose asthma is brought on by inhaling various dusts and pollens. A cousin of Dr. S. Weir Mitchell, and one of the sanest and most normal of men, suffered greatly if a cat, invisible to him, were in an adjoining room. This phenomenon moved the great novelist to write a fine paper on Allorophobia (the fear of cats) the charm of which would entice any reader, and in which sufficient instances are given to convince any skeptic.

There is not space for details here. But one may state in general terms that cats are disease carriers, either by having infectious germs nesting only in their fur or by harboring the fleas, lice, and other insects that convey to man the specific causes of typhus, plague, relapsing fever; or cats in sick rooms become infected by prowling about the discharges of typhoid fever patients, and the like; or cats themselves suffer diphtheria, tuberculosis, and grippa, and spread the germs by such infectious diseases—by coughing, sneezing, or spitting (as they do in anger); or germs such as those of tetanus may traverse the human skin that is scratched or laid open by the cat's claws. Then, again, the germs (as of foot-and-mouth disease) are likely to be in blisters or sores in the cat's mouth, to be smeared in its spittle with its paws, then rubbed over its face and its body in the familiar way. Not a few children have contracted disease from cats thus infected being huddled in their arms, and probably allowed to lick their faces.

Tag the Cat? In January last there was foot-and-mouth disease in at least eighteen of our cats. The New York State Department's bulletin tells us that fowl, cats, and dogs have frequently been the means of conveying this very easily spread infection from farm to farm and cities among the methods adopted in this country for controlling this infection the killing at once of dogs, cats, and chickens, for the prevention of possible dissemination through the agency of those creatures.
