

## YACHTSMEN AT ST. MATTHEW'S

Rev. Dr. Morison, Chaplain,  
Speaks to R. K. Y. C.  
Members

Uses River to Illustrate Theme  
of Secret of Soul Tran-  
quillity

Royal Kennebecasis Yacht Club members attended service last evening in St. Matthew's Church and were welcomed by their chaplain, Rev. Dr. J. A. Morison, who addressed them on the "Secret of Soul Tranquillity," taking as his text the words from the Prophet Isaiah: "O that thou hadst hearkened to my commandments then hadst thou peace as a river."

ON THE SAINT JOHN.

Dr. Morison said in part: "Tonight as we gather here, inevitably by the law of association of ideas, we think of the river upon whose waters season after season, we spend so many happy days and on whose banks we gather for our annual service. A more glorious river than the Saint John it would be difficult to find in all the world. "There is nothing unspiritual in this wandering of our thoughts to these scenes of our pleasures, for the river speaks also to our hearts of moral truth and virtue of heavenly mindedness and spiritual hopes. "Our race launched its career by the side of a river and when the inspired seers sought some surpassing symbol by which to suggest the glories of the eternal land he pictured a pure river of water of life clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God. "Humanity has ever felt the lure of the river, and has loved to wander by its sides, sail upon its waters, and build its dwelling places by its banks. Many of the world's greatest cities have been founded by the sides of rivers, and we cannot think of London with its Thames or Paris without its Seine or Rome without its Tiber. So Montreal has the St. Lawrence, Ottawa the Ottawa and Saint John our own beloved river famous alike in history and in use."

### THE MODERN HIGHWAY.

The river constituted the first highway, continued Dr. Morison, there was the ironroad, the stone road and the water road but the water way or road was always the first and for the most part determined the location and route of the other two. Few subjects were more inviting than the evolution of the modern highway. Wild cattle roamed across the plains seeking the rivers. These were followed by the red men, who thus marked their first trails and in turn on same the white man with all his caravan of stuff called civilization. All came to the river and there found ever welcome and mighty ally in all that pertains to the satisfying of the wants and ministering to the aspirations of this present life. From time immemorial the world's prophets had also sought the river side and there, grasping its subtle secrets, they had proclaimed to a thirsting humanity the soul refreshing truths of Good and the spiritual world.

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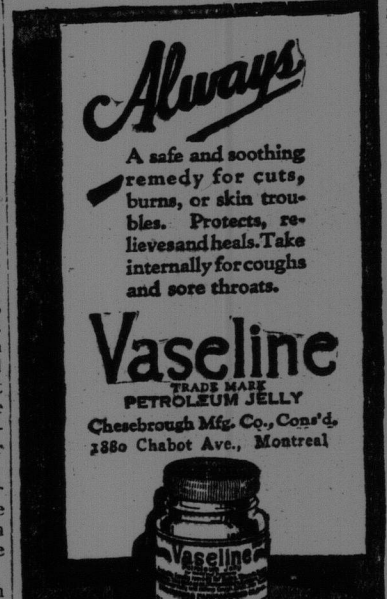

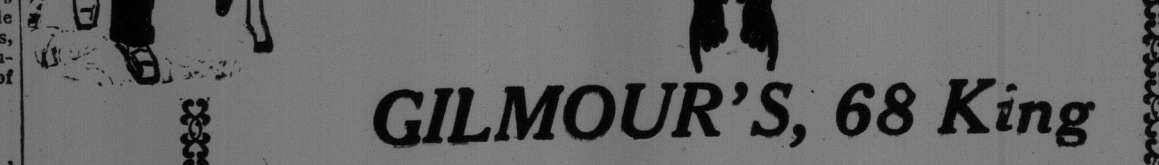
