WAR MATERIALS TO STRANGE USES

Anti-Gas Rattles Used By Farmers As Bird Scare—Rum Jars Now Contain Ink, Varnish and Disinfectants.

London, March 20.—Strange uses are being found for some of the hundreds of thousands of tons of surplus material which the British army found on its hands at the armistice. The ministry of munitions is trying to encourage trades to convert the material into goods suitable for commerce. And many trades are showing remarkable ingenuity in the matter.

Few would have supposed for instance that there was money in the lining of a steel helmet, or that flanged wheels for toy locomotives could be made out of an anti-gas apparatus. A University Service correspondent, who was shown over the new sample rooms of the miscellaneous stores section of the disposal board by an official, was told of one ingenious trader who bought up thousands of rubber rings taken from the lining of steel helmets and was selling them as paper quoits.

Anti-gas supplies are being bought and used by farmers as bird scare, rifle clips as supports for curtain rods, and old gas cylinders have been converted into stoves suitable for the conservatory. Even copper wire carriers with leather handles, which were attached to ammunition boxes, had been converted into handles for ladies' bags of the heavier kind. These triumphs of conversion are of recent date.

Here is a list of goods before and after conversion: 9 foot dog chains, anchor chains for punts and light river craft, X-ray negatives, glass cut up for photo lenses, diamond panes, lids for dolls' houses, lantern slides and stable lamp glasses. Empty cartridge cases, disc boxes, wooden blocks, toys, gas fans, used in trenches, movie and fluoro fans. Rum jars (three million for disposal), ink, varnish and disinfectant containers. Signalling shutters, advertising signs. Tin boxes and vases, suitable for artist's brushes, tea and money boxes.

Thousands of wooden tooth brushes were made for the Indian army. Tooth brushes are sometimes made from the bones of the bull, but as the Mohammedan religion regards this animal as sacred the war office had to manufacture tooth brushes of wood. Thousands of these are for sale and they made excellent varnish and metal brushes.
