2. In returning the remission after completion by the
Commandant, Military Detention Barracks, No. 63, to Commander,
Petawawa Military Camp, the delay was explained but appar-
ently this information was not passed on.

3. Upon receipt of the letter from the Commander, Petawawa
Military Camp, enclosing the remission requesting that it be
made effective 10 Apr 44, it was misplaced in the Central
Registry at this Headquarters and came to notice on 1st May.
Steps were then immediately taken to have the remission
promulgated. At that time the matter was taken up with the
W/ C in charge of Central Registry at this Headquarters.
