Many North End citizens in discussing the rescue, said it was just what was to be expected of Rogers, who is one of the best liked young men of that

James Kelley in speaking with the Sun said Rogers and he had been working together ever since the season opened, and he went down because "he considered it his duty to do what he could," He said that after they had gone on board the tug boat, Rogers had held out his hand saying "Shake, old pal, we're lucky to escape." Kelley's muscles were somewhat sore from the strain but he was able to call on Daley and find out how he was progressing. When the reporter called on Daley, the young man was in bed, laughingly telling of his experience. He said when he went over he gave up all hope of being saved and could not find words to express his thanks to his rescuers. He said that as he fell he struck the side of the steamer, and after that everything was a jumble to him until he woke up on the tug boat. He complained last evening of a severe headache but otherwise was feeling fairly well after his experience. "A funny thing," he said, "about the accident is, that when I was knocked overboard I had a pipe in my mouth, and it remained there until after I had got on the tug."
