among the Records of the faid Court; and within days after the lapfe of other fix months a like other duplicate fhall be transmitted and remain among the faid Records, and fo be continued by the faid Trustee at the end of every months, until the Estate may be finally divided and closed; and extracts from fuch writings, figned by a Prothonotary of the aforefaid Court, shall bear evidence in all Courts of Justice and the faid Register and the Bankrupt's Books and Papers and the whole other Papers in the Trustees bouds shall at all times be made public and be open to the face access of any Creditor who may defire to fee the fame.

Court &c. 10 make intrim ordertine-feot Apveals.

Every Creditor may join in the perition for foquefication; and death of a Credistor or of Eanknupl thall not flay penceedings. XLVIII. And be it-further enacted that if any Appeal thall be made from any interfocutory order of any Court having power under this A& to adjudge, and where legally fuch appeal may be had, it thall be lawful and competent to the Court holding Jurifdiction, to make fuch orders and direct fuch Proceedings, notwithflanding any fuch appeal, as shall appear to be neceffary for prevorting the Effate of the Debtor from being embezzled, fecreted, unmaged celeffened, while any fuch appeal may be pending, and every flep may in the mean time be taken in the recovery of the Bankrupte Effate, and the distribution thereof, that is not repugnent or informations to the interests which the party appealing by the appeal infifts upon.

XLIX And be it further enacted that when any Petition for fequefication under the authority of this Act may be preferred, it thall be competent for any other Creditor to concur therein, and to follow up and ourfue the fame even without the confent or after the death of the Creditor or Creditors originally petitioning, and the expence therein fhall be diffuried and repaid by the Truftee out of the first monies that comes into his hands; and if the Bankrupt shall happen to die during any fuch Proceedings under this Act, the lane may and shall lawfully be carried on and purfuel as if the faid Bankrupt were living, any Law to the contrary notwirinstanding.
