Time for return of immigrant limited. 16. Any alien who comes into Canada in violation of the law, may be returned as by law provided, at any time within one year thereafter, at the expense of the person, vessel, transportation company or corporation bringing him into Canada; and any alien who becomes a charge upon the public within one year after his arrival in Canada, from causes existing prior to his landing therein, shall be deemed to have come in violation of law and may be returned as aforesaid.

Application of Act.

17. This Act shall apply only to such foreign countries as have enacted and retained in force, or as enact or retain in 10 force, laws or ordinances, applying to Canada, of a character similar to this Act.
