An Act for making perpetual so much of an Act, made in the Thirty-fifth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for better securing the Duties on Glass, as was to continue in force for a limited Time; and to continue several Laws relating to the granting a Bounty upon certain Species of *British* and *Irish* Linens exported, and taking off the Duties on the Importation of Foreign Raw Linen Yarns made of Flax; until the Twenty-fourth Day of *June* One thousand eight hundred and one; to the better Encouragement of the making of Sail Cloth in *Great Britain*, to the encouraging the Manufacture of *British* Sail Cloth, and securing the Duties on Foreign-made Sail Cloth imported, to the securing the Duties upon Foreign-made Sail Cloth, and charging Foreign-made Sails with a Duty, until the Twenty-ninth Day of *September* One thousand eight hundred and four, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament; to the regulating the Fees of the Officers of the Customs, and of the Naval Officers in the
