And Canadians are employed in opening and developing Canadian mines. I am told our average loaded train is profitably hauled at the established price per mile which is \$5.65 and adding one half of freight per mile we get \$5.65 / 185 = \$5.48 which freight pays for hauling the empties back to starting point. And (distance) 2200 multipled by \$5.48 = \$12.056 freight paid on train. Same train composed of fifty cars each carring fifty tons = 2500 tons at \$6.00 per ton will pay a freight of \$15.000 and thus a difference in favour of hauling coal by ton is what this Association is asking for. what this Association is asking for.
