results. Meantime though it is wise statesmanship to regard the western farmers as our fellow citizens and spater no pains to lay the facts before them and reason with them and get at least a substantial portion of them behind us. This can be done. My experience is that where one man learns from argument one hundred learn from experience. Experience is now our pedagogue and the bitter results of tariff tampering and instability will bring home the truth to thousands.

I believe with Mr. Sparks that you are eminently the right man to take this task in hand and sincerely hope you will decide to do so.
