Ottawa, 21st July, 1917.

Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant and to say that the resignation of Peter Jones as Constable for the Restigouche Indian reserve is hereby accepted, and the appointment of John Barnaby to succeed him is approved.

As regards the letter signed by yourself, the Chief, Councillors and Ex-Councillors, I may say that the denial of the charges made against Constable Fidele Landry are assumed to include that of having used the obscene language referred to by Peter Jones, as it must be evident that if he were guilty of this offence mentioned he would not be a fit person to hold the office of Constable.
