MECHANIZATION

23. (a) Design

- (1) Universal Carrier Bogie Spring Test (with 1000-1b overload)
 The test has been discontinued at 1950 miles with no
 failure having occurred. The springs will be submitted
 for chemical and metallographical analysis.
- (ii) Scout Car Development of hy duty tires, rated at 2500 lbs, to provide greater load capacity, is being undertaken and preliminary tests are satisfactory. It was found, however, that present rear axle and tire combination provide insufficient safety factor for larger tires. A new rear axle assembly using the 15-cwt 4 x 2 crown gear will be tested and will provide required safety factor. This will affect interchangeability of parts but axle assemblies will be fully interchangeable.
