scheme of children's allowances. As they would be wholly within federal jurisdiction, there is no impediment to their enactment at once.

The scope of unemployment insurance should be extended as widely as is practicable, as a further step towards a national minimum. Unemployment insurance protects the wage earner against a sudden loss of income through the lack of work; similarly a floor under farm and fish prices will protect farmers and fishermen against a sudden loss of income through a lack of markets. The government is already committed to a floor under farm prices and it was probably only through inadvertance that fish prices were not included. They are also recommended by the Liberal Federation.

SUMMARY

To sum up, a statement of post-war policy might include:

1. Intention to co-operate with other nations in maintaining peace after victory.
2. Intention to share fully in relief and rehabilitation of devastated nations.
3. Readiness to co-operate in laying foundations of world prosperity through development of trade (Re-iterate New York statement commended by Mr. Hull)
