- Q. Would it be beer?
- A. No sir.
- Q. Whiskey?
- A. I wasn't in a position to say.
- Q. How could you say it wasn't beer?
- A. I wouldn't say so.
- Q. Was it wine?
- A. I couldn't say.

QUESTIONS ASKED BY PROSECUTING OFFER

- Q. Will you explain for the benefit of the Court the arrangements made for the convenient functioning of the HQ when the CBO Staff is with us. What usual arrangements are made regarding water vehs?
- A. We have a water trailer, 180 gals; CBO has a 15 cwt, 250 gals. In order to have everything running smoothly the 15 cwt of the CBO looks after the men's kitchen and our 180 gal trailer looks after the water for the offr's mess.
- Q. And what veh is normally used for towing that water trailer?
- A. Foster's 15 cwt.
- Q. Does Foster's 15 cwt have any other duties?
- A. It is used for picking up stores, and on convoys used for moving the offr's mess, and other little jobs when we are in a position.
- Q. In the situation with the CBO do you have any directing duties around the Offrs Mess?
- A. No sir.
- Q. Who looks after them?
- A. Bdr. Maughn.
- Q. Every time the offr's mess needs water do you specifically order some one to go?
- A. No, not everytime. Generally the dvr asks me and I tell the dvr to go.
- Q. Then normally it is the duty of the dvr to keep the water trailer filled?
- A. Yes sir.

QUESTIONS ASKED BY THE COURT

- Q. Was Foster on parade that morning?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. You don't know of any definite order for drivers for exchanging vehs?
- A. I have told them.
