twelfth day of December, in the year of our Lord one Thousand
nine hundred and twenty-one:

BETWEEN:

ALEXANDER ALFRED FLUMMER,
of the City of Vancouver, Province
of British Columbia, Lumberman,
hereinafter called the

"ASSIGNOR" OF THE FIRST PART.

-and-

ROSS PEERS And ARTHUR DAVID
ANDERSON, both of the City of
Vancouver, Province of British
Columbia, Lumbermen, hereinafter
called the

"ASSIGNEE" OF THE SECOND PART.

WHEREAS by Articles of Agreement dated the 21st
day of February A.D.1919, and made between the Deputy
Superintendent General of Indian Affairs, representing the
Indian Tribe on the Sliammon Reserve, of the First Part
and Alexander Alfred Plummer, Ross Peers and Arthur David
Anderson therein called "Peers, Anderson & Plummer" of the
Second Part, the said Deputy Superintendent of Indian Affairs
undertook to cut and deliver to the said Peers, Anderson and
Plummer all of the merchantable timber on Harwood Island
for the price, and upon the terms and subject to the
conditions as more fully set out in the Agreement now in
recital.

AND WHEREAS the Party of the First Part has agreed to
assign, transfer and relinquish unto the Parties of the Second
Part, the said Articles of Agreement and all his interest therein,
and in and to the timber therein referred to.
