Any person offending against any of the provi-Penalty. sions of the next preceding section, shall, for every such offence incur a fine of fifty dollars to be recovered, with full costs of suit, by any one who shall sue for the same in the recorder's court; and any person offending in any of the cases aforesaid, being lawfully convicted thereof, shall forever forfeit his right to vote at any municipal election in the said city, or to be elected inayor or alderman of the said city for a term of three years.
 - 44. All votes given in violation of any of the fore-Votes nulligoing provisions shall be null and void.
