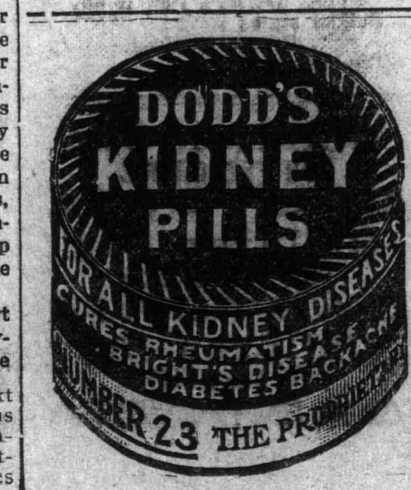

GERMANY BEATEN SAYS TIM HEALY

Intended to Demand One Thousand Million Dollars From Paris.

NEW YORK, Oct. 5.—Timothy M. Healy, the Irish M.P., who arrived in New York yesterday on the Campania, when interviewed by a correspondent, expressed confidence in the ultimate defeat of the Kaiser's armies in the campaign in France. "The Kaiser," the Irish leader said, "has lost all the admiration which the world had bestowed upon him and Germany by the manner in which she attacked Belgium to make a short-cut to Paris. The success of her strategy depended on that move. She has lost. She intended to hold Paris for a ransom of a thousand-million dollars, with the alternative of burning the city."

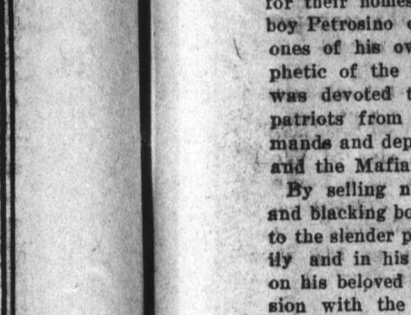

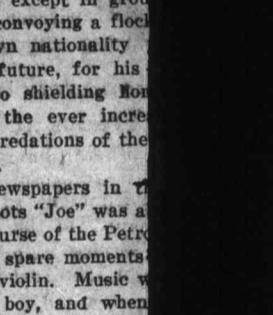
