

DEEMING DECLARED GUILTY

Australasian Jack-the-Ripper Will be Tried for Murder.

A WILD BOONE AT THE INQUEST.

These books are arranged by States in a series of drawers set in a handsome oak cabinet. The drawers are numbered, and each one contains a copy of the petition printed on it and signed by 115,000 others.
