(c) To make, build, construct, erect, lay down and maintain and operate reservoirs, water-works, dams, canals, tunnels, culverts, flumes, conduits, main and other pipes and appliances and to execute and do all other works and things necessary or convenient for obtaining, storing, selling, delivering, measuring and distributing water for the generation, maintenance and development of hydraulic, electrical or other mechanical power, or for irrigating land or for any other purpose of the company; (d) To construct, improve, work, maintain, manage, carry out or complete and to purchase, lease or otherwise acquire and to hold, use, sell, lease or otherwise dispose of any lands, works, mains, machinery or any roads, ways, bridges, reservoirs, water-courses, wharves, manufactories, warehouses, electrical works, shops, stores and other works and conveniences which may seem capable of being used or operated in connection with any part of the company's undertaking for the time being, or calculated directly or indirectly to benefit the company and to equip, maintain and operate by electric, hydraulic or other mechanical power all works belonging to the company or in which the company may be interested, and to contribute to, subsidize or otherwise assist or take part in the construction, improvement, maintenance, working, management, carrying out or control thereof;
