## ST. JOHN'S MUNICIPAL COUNCIL.

### Public Notice.

At the Regular Meeting of the St. John's Municipal Council, held March 29th, the following Resolution regarding the removal of ashes from the streets in the City by the Sanitary Department was adopted, viz:—

RESOLVED—On and after April 15th next, every occupant of a dwelling house shall deposit the garbage and ashes of the house, which he inhabits or occupies, in metal water tight covered receptacles, which can be handled by one man, and shall place the said receptacles on the street as close as possible to the sidewalk opposite to his dwelling house, or in such other place as may be designated, and on the days and hours appointed by the Sanitary Supervisor; and no person shall place any such receptacle on the streets on any day except during the hours so fixed.

Provided, however, that the Council may contract with the occupants of dwelling houses, on payment of a fee, to have the ashes and garbage taken from the receptacles in the yards of said dwelling houses.

All receptacles shall be removed from the streets, by persons who have deposited the same thereon, as soon as possible after the employees of the Sanitary Department have made their round.
