Wheat, 90c to 91c per bushel. Oats, 39c to 40c per bushel. Peas, 63c to 66c per bushel.

There was a fair market today, and owing to the splendid condition of the sleighing a large number came in to town. A fair supply of grain came forward, and prices remained steady at our tabular quotations.

Wheat had no advance from 90 cents per bushel. Oats were at \$1.17 to \$1.19 per cental.

Barley, \$1 for feeding qualities and \$1.15 for malting. Peas, \$1.10 to \$1.20 per cental.

The meat market had a fair supply, and good beef at \$6.50 per cwt, by the carcass.

There was no change in poultry. Butter remained at 18 cents a pound for best roll; 16 cents for crocks.

Potatoes raised to 70 cents a bag wholesale, and 80 cents retail. Apples scarce at \$1.25 a bag, and \$3.25 per bbl.

Kansas City, Dec. 30.—Cattle—Receipts, 280; shipments, 1,720; market 5c to 10c higher; steers, \$3 50 to \$5; cows, \$2 to \$3.25; stouers and feeders, \$2.25 to \$3.25.

New York, December 31.—Beaves—Receipts, 1,044, all direct to exporters and slaughterers; no trade; feeling firm; dressed beef steady, at 6c to 7c; shipments to-day, 830 beaves; to-morrow, 200 beaves and 3,000 quarters of beef.

East Buffalo, Dec. 31.—Cattle—About six cars of common stock still held from Monday's market, and two cars of fresh stock sold steadily at Monday's figures.

The cattle trade for 1890 has been less satisfactory than anticipated. Offerings on this market were for the year 11,465 cars, a decrease as compared with last year of 294 cars.

The number of cattle slaughtered in this city this year was 74,180 head, an increase of about 13,000 head. Prices are generally lower than last year, but only slightly so, except for the very common grades.
