LONDON, Dec. 28.—News from Egypt is not of the most satisfactory character. Gen. Wolsley has decided to abandon the attempt to reach Shendi by the desert route from Korti, thus cutting off a great bend in the Nile.

Gen. Wolsley is far from satisfied with the arrangements for the expedition. He has sent furious complaints to the war office of inefficiency and absolute break down of transport and commissary services.

Although a good two months has elapsed since the place was left, the force of 1500 of the 7000 men composing the fall force of the expedition have reached Korti.

British envoys have left Korti for the Kabbalah and other tribes, which are only weakly attached to the mahdi's cause.

A SCHEME OF CONSOLIDATION AGREED ON.

At the Recent Conference—All the Colleges Said to Favor It—An Outline of the Proposal.

The World has been able to gather from various sources an outline of the scheme of university consolidation approved at the last conference of the representatives of the various institutions, which scheme will be submitted to their respective governing bodies on the same day, January 9.

Briefly, the scheme is as follows: There shall be one university, bearing the name of the university of Toronto. It shall possess a professorate, whose lectures shall be delivered free of charge in the school of practical science and in those lectures rooms of University college not used by that institution. To facilitate this professors shall deal only with secular subjects, such as the natural sciences, mathematics, psychology and logic, avoiding those that may have any connection with ethics and religion.
