

A CLOSE CALL FOR SAMPLER.

Mr. H. Benham's Disagreeable Discovery
In a Berlin Hotel.

Mr. H. Benham, of H. Benham & Co., No. 10 Melinda-street, had a rather close call in Berlin on the evening of last night. He arrived in that town on the evening in question and registered at the American Hotel. Pleased With the Train.

Editor World: I have read the two letters which appeared in your issue of yesterday and to-day in regard to the suburban service on the G.T.R. between Mimico and Toronto, and I suppose that any change, however satisfactory it might be on the whole, would give rise to some fault-finding. "South Parkdale" starts off in his letter "we, residents, etc." as though he was armed with authority to speak for everybody in that district, and then he drops into the singular "I have made enquiries." "I would like to know," etc., from which one would infer that he is speaking for himself alone. It is, however, quite clear from the time table that he is not fully conversant with the needs of the various districts and that if his ideas were adopted he would in all probability cause a loss of greater share of adverse criticism than the superintendent of the G.T.R. has done. For example, residents of High Park, Swansea, Hunter and Mimico Grove who wish to reach their offices at 9 or 10 would, under the proposed time table, have to take the train leaving Mimico at 7.15, as the next train would not reach the City Hall till 8.40. "South Parkdale" and "Suburbanite" would like a train which would enable them to go home to get a warm dinner in the middle of the day. Most business men nowadays have only time to run out for half an hour for lunch, and this train, I think, would be but a little patronized. Whether "South Parkdale's" time table could be made to fit in with the running arrangements of the numerous other trains, both passenger and freight, on that line is a question about which there may be some doubt, and which could only be answered by a practical railway man.

I am a constant traveler on the suburban trains and have taken the trouble to ascertain how the present time table is regarded, and with the exception of one or two gentlemen who would like fast perhaps not unreasonable to see the 5.10 train leaving Toronto at 5.15 or 5.30, everyone seems to think having regard to the fact that Mimico still the terminus of the double track that it is a very satisfactory time table indeed. A train each way every hour would, no doubt, be very convenient, one every half hour would be still more so; but the traffic would, perhaps, hardly warrant that yet, and it would therefore be unreasonable to expect it.

The present time table is the best we have ever had, as the trains are more frequent at the hours when they are most needed, and in comparing it with the one in your issue of May 14th traveling public will not doubt come to the conclusion that our train arrangements are perhaps better managed by the superintendent of the G.T.R. than they would be by "South Parkdale," however much the latter may wish to the contrary.

Smallpox Among Mission Preachers.

New York Sun: Last October smallpox broke out in the Foodschinsky and Provinsky districts of the Government of Odesa, on the coast of Lake Ladoga. Since then the plague has spread throughout the region, and is still unabated. In the villages and towns where the scourge has appeared it has killed many of the children. The people of Odesa regard smallpox (Opa) as a divinity to be propitiated and not angered. They call it "Opa Ivanova."

"Matoshiba (little mother) Opa"—appellations which imply profound respect. Since vaccination is a means to oppose it, they believe that it would be a sin to be vaccinated and try to avoid the operation by all possible means. As soon as a person gets sick with the disease all the children of the village are dressed as nicely as the parents can afford to take to his house to pay their respects to Opa Ivanova. They take cakes and fruit to the house of the invalid, which they deposit on a table placed by his bedside for the purpose. Then they kiss the sick person on the forehead, and sit down around him for some time, talking and partaking of the food they had brought with them. Or, if one of the victims who has been taken to the hospital, the children are five miles to salute Little Mother Opa in this way. As long as there is a child in the house the rooms must be cleaned and the inmates may not wash or shave or change their garments. Rough expressions or curses may be pronounced in a house where there is a smallpox patient. If one of the victims involuntarily from the lips, the offender must forthwith kiss the invalid by way of protesting against his own fault. No medicine is given to the patient, but he must be bathed in hot water twice a day.

The presents which the children bring must be left on the table by his bedside for the purpose of taking of the invalid. The presents are deeply rooted among the peasants of the village and are not to be despised. The disease despite all efforts made by the more civilized.

At the Sessions.
Before Judge Morgan yesterday Donald Chapman of Georgian township was discharged after an admission as to the results of quarrelling with his brother Murray & Chapman. Blanche Harris, on a charge of fortune-telling, was found not guilty. The case against William Crawford, charged with having caused grievous bodily harm to William Clarkson, was put over to the next Assizes. The case against Eli Jones and Edward Rowand, charged with removing household goods, the property of Frederick Hill, were transferred to the next sessions.

A New School For the East End.
A meeting of the Sites and Building Committee of the Public School Board was held yesterday afternoon. Trustee McCracken in the chair. On motion of Trustee McCracken it was resolved that the site for a school on the east side of Kippendavie-avenue, close to Queen-street east, having a frontage of 100 feet by 200 feet deep, at \$25 per foot, be approved, and that the same be recommended to the Board for adoption subject to the passing of a Public School estimates by the City Council.
