NEWS FROM ACROSS THE SEA.

INTELLIGENCE FROM FOREIGN COURTESIES EVERYWHERE.

Great Damages From Floods in the United States—Jack the Ripper Again—The Labor Troubles in Paris Seem Leading Towards a Truce.

LONDON, June 26.—A letter identical in style and writing with previous missives from Jack the Ripper has been received by the chairman of the vigilance committee in Whitechapel, in which Jack announces that he is about to perform another "operation," and that if the vigilance committee attempt to track him he will kill them to the heart. He is the duty of the police, he says, to catch him. He adds that he has been nearly caught twice, but will never be taken alive. Patrols and vigilantes were revived tonight, and Scotland Yard sent an extraordinary contingent to Whitechapel.

An Old Seaman's Suicide. LONDON, June 26.—Capt. Nease of the Norwegian ship Arizon, from Pensacola, which arrived at Liverpool June 10, committed suicide by shooting himself with a revolver in the cabin of his vessel.
